



2009 EagleBank Bowl

The EagleBank Bowl is an annual college football bowl game played in Washington, D.C.'s historic RFK Stadium. Organized jointly by the **Washington Convention and Sports Authority**, title sponsor **EagleBank** and the **DC Bowl Committee**, this year's bowl game is set for Tuesday, December 29 at 4:30 p.m. In addition to the bowl game, EagleBank Bowl week includes an array of activities for the whole family to enjoy including the Tailgate Party at the DC Armory, the Teams Luncheon and Welcome Receptions.

In the inaugural game last year, Wake Forest rallied in the second half to defeat Navy, 29-19, kicking off the EagleBank Bowl game tradition in grand style. The year, the Temple University Owls end a 30-year bowl game drought and will matchup against the Bruins of UCLA. It is the first-ever meeting between the two football programs.

The EagleBank Bowl and its partners are committed to making a positive economic and philanthropic impact in the Washington, D.C. area, enhancing community pride through its support of charitable and community programs and business alliance initiatives and honoring the military for their courage, sacrifice and dedication in service to our nation.

The charity partner of the EagleBank Bowl is the Wounded Warrior Project, an organization that honors and empowers wounded warriors. The partnership between the EagleBank Bowl and WWP serves the dual purpose of raising awareness of WWP and the needs of severely injured servicemen and women while helping to raise funds to support its programs.

The EagleBank Bowl will hold the game's official Tailgate Party at the DC Armory on December 29 from 12:30 – 4:30 p.m. The Tailgate Party will feature an all-you-can-eat buffet with food provided by popular D.C. restaurants and \$2 beer specials. Admission is \$20 for adults, \$15 for children ages 4-12 and free for children 3 and under.

For the Tailgate Party, the restaurants include local favorites Clyde's, Tony & Joe's, J. Paul's and Old Glory. Also on the day's menu is plenty of music and entertainment including appearances by live bands, pep bands and cheerleaders from the participating schools. EA Sports will provide interactive games onsite including Xbox and Nintendo Wii, as well as raffle off games to attending fans.

The theme for this year's Bowl game, "**DCember Rocks at RFK**," is a tribute to the Bowl game's month and city location and is intended to elicit high energy and anticipation for the game as well as encourage people to come out to the stadium for a rockin' good time. Fans through the years have enjoyed RFK Stadium's legendary bouncy seats and rockin' stands for a variety of sporting events.
